Flexible Engagement on Intellectual Property

Examples of our primary programmes would include the following.

- Initiatives aimed at training a core group of individuals (government and/or private sector) on the links between the benefits of IPR and economic growth. Individuals participating in these workshops would also be trained to deliver training to others. The primary target audiences would be policy makers, individual entrepreneurs and business associations.
- Partnering with a university/universities to create an IPR clinic for law and business students. This would involve curriculum development and providing an opportunity to train future lawyers for work on IPR legal issues. An IPR clinic would also have a component for practising lawyers to take courses to add to their existing areas of legal practice.
- Programmes targeting the domestic practising legal community. The objective would be to expand the legal expertise of practising lawyers to include legal representation and business counselling relating to IPR issues.
- Programmes targeting business/creative groups aimed at raising awareness of ways to improve commercialization of innovative/creative products and securing IPR protections for the domestic and export markets.
